

HOW TO CHECK GPS CHART PLOTTER VERSION

For KP-708, KP-708A, KCombo-7, KCombo-7A

1. Check the serial no. of your GPS Chart Plotter
2. If after the model, there is:
Number **2**, then the unit is **MKII**. (Use **MKII Firmware Update**)
Otherwise, it is **MKI**. (Use **MKI Firmware Update**)

Example: KP-708:

S/No. 708**2**70800107

Model ————

————— **MKII Version**

NOTE:

- MKI **CANNOT** use MKII Update
- MKI **CANNOT** use K-Chart 3.0 Map
- MKI **CANNOT** use Navionics+

For KP-1299 Series (KP-1299, KP-1299A, KP-1299C)

1. Check the serial no. of your GPS Chart Plotter
2. If after the model, there is:
 - 2**, then the unit is **MKII**. (Use **MKII Firmware Update**)
 - 3** and **4**, indicates it is New Generation (Use **MKII New Gen Firmware Update**)
 - Otherwise it is **MKI**. (Use **MKI Firmware Update**)

Example: **KP-1299A New Generation**

S/No. 1299A4H210400069-B
Model ———— with HDMI
3 or 4 ————
means New Generation

Example: **KP-1299C MKII ONLY**

S/No. 1299C2210400069-B
Model ———— MKII

NOTE:

- MKII **MUST** use MKII Firmware Update
- 1299 New Gen **MUST** use New Gen Firmware of KP-1299X Firmware
- MKI **CANNOT** use MKII Update
- MKI **CANNOT** use K-Chart 3.0 Map
- MKI **CANNOT** use Navionics+

KP-8299, KP-8299A, KP-8299C

1. Check the serial no. of your GPS Chart Plotter
2. After the model,
 - a. If **no Valid date** after the model and number "2", it is **MKI**.

Sample:

S/No. 8299A211569-44

Model

Not a valid date
after "2" means MKI

- b. If it is a valid date but **BEFORE the year 2017**, it is **MKI**.
(Use **MKI Firmware Update**)

Sample:

S/No. 829921105003

Model

Date is May 2011
means MKI
(date is before 2017)

- c. If after the model and after "2", and then date is 2017 onwards, it is **MKII**. (Use **MKII Firmware Update**)

Sample:

S/No. 829922011003

Model

Date is Nov. 2020
means MKII
(date is after 2017)

NOTE:

- MKII **MUST** use MKII Firmware Update
- ALL KP-8299 **BEFORE** the year 2017 are **ALL MKI**.
- MKI **CANNOT** use MKII Update
- MKI **CANNOT** use K-Chart 3.0 Map
- MKI **CANNOT** use Navionics+

KP-38S, KP-38, KP-38A, KP-39, KP-39A and KP-1299X are ALL MKII.

- Use **MKII Firmware Update**
- Can use KChart 3.0 Update
- Can use with Navionics+

KP-6299, KP-6299C are ALL MKI.

- Use **MKI Firmware Update**
- MKI **CANNOT** use MKII Update
- MKI **CANNOT** use K-Chart 3.0 Map
- MKI **CANNOT** use Navionics+

KP-6299A

1. Check the serial no. of your GPS Chart Plotter
2. If after the model, there is:
Number **2**, then the unit is **MKII**. (Send us an email for **KP-6299A MKII Firmware**)
Otherwise, it is **MKI**. (Use **MKI Firmware Update**)

Example:

S/No. 6299A21611003

Model

means MKII
